## Danny Romaniuk

Born: March 25, 1925  
Gorlitz, Saskatchewan  
Died: 1976

Country & western artist from Gorlitz, Saskatchewan. Played at dances with his father at the age of 7. He mastered the violin, guitar, banjo, mandolin, & string bass. Spent years touring with western swing bands in Canada & the U.S.A.. In 1956 he was a featured member of the Cavaliers trio on CKNW radio on the Canadian West Coast for 5 years. Also frequently seen & heard on CBC-TV & a regular member of he Cross Canada Barn Dance on CBC during this time.

Recorded 2 albums for Aragon Records while living and working out of Vancouver, BC in the 1950's with his band, 'Danny Romaniuk and the Tumbling Tumbleweeds'.
